

Bylaws of the BoardMeetings Open to the Public

~~The public is invited to attend all regular and special meetings of the Board as spectators. The press of business and the shortage of time require that they do not participate in the discussions of the Board. The Superintendent will provide a place on the agenda for interested parties to address the Board and solicit opinions of the spectators present.~~

~~Citizens who wish to present any matter of concern to the School Board may make requests, and shall be permitted to address the Board at the appropriate place on the agenda. Persons addressing the board must state their name and address for the record. All citizens attending the regular or annual school board meeting must sign the meeting register.~~

All School Board meetings shall be open to the public, except executive sessions. While the public has the right to attend such meetings, no individuals or groups have the right to enter into the deliberations of the Board. They may take part in the discussion only when the Board invites them to do so.

Because the Board desires to hear the viewpoints of citizens throughout the District, opportunity will be provided for the public to speak at regular Board meetings.
