Subject: New Course Recommendation

Please forward the following new course recommendations to the School Board for consideration of approval for the 2012-2013 school year. These course proposals have been reviewed by principals, coordinators, and the administrative cabinet and are recommended for approval. Course descriptions are attached for review purposes.

Language Arts: Reading the World- This is a non-fiction course that will fulfill a ½ credit reading emphasis requirement for graduation. Research strongly recommends that schools provide non-fiction literature options for students in high school.

Mathematics: College and Career Ready Mathematics - This course supports students who have completed Algebra 1 and Geometry but who are not ready to move on to an Algebra 2 course.

Automotive coursework:

Basic Auto Mechanics – This is an introductory and prerequisite course for other advanced automotive coursework.

Advanced Automotive Mechanics – This is a continuation course from Basic Automotive Mechanics and if completed successfully will enable students to receive 2 transcribed credits of automotive coursework at NTC.

Auto Technology I – This course teaches students skills necessary for a position as an entry-level automotive technician. Course credits can be transcribed at NTC and helps prepare students for ASE certifications.

Auto Technology II – This course builds on skills learned in Auto Tech I and continues to reinforce skills necessary for a position as an entry-level automotive technician. Course credits can be transcribed at NTC and helps prepare students for ASE certifications.
