School Medication Policy

Wisconsin Statute 118.29 governs the administration of medications in the school setting. The number of students requiring the administration of medication during the school day continues to increase due to chronic health conditions, student behavioral issues and acute care needs. It is the goal of this District to provide safe and appropriate medication administration to ensure that students requiring medication during the school day will be able to attend school. This will be done in accordance with the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing.

The administration of medications in the school setting will be directed by a District Registered Nurse in conjunction with a physician functioning as an independent contractor in the role of Medical Director, both of whom are licensed to practice in Wisconsin and are in good professional standing. The District Nurse(s) will direct and monitor medication administration by designated school personnel in accordance with state statutes and regulations and District procedures.
