

Board Policy

Policy Development

The School Board of the D. C. Everest Area School District is a policy making body. The role and function of the Board is to adopt policies which will guide the actions of those to whom it delegates authority. These policies will be recorded in writing and organized according to a standard policy classification system.

In formulating policies, the Board will adopt general principles and statements of intent. The Superintendent will, when necessary or when directed by the Board, prepare written regulations or rules to ensure the implementation of Board policy.

Policies and/or revisions may be proposed by any member of the Board, the administration, by any citizen group or organization, or by any individual citizen. The Superintendent, in cooperation with staff and the Board, will recommend policies for adoption and recommend revision of existing policies. Recommended policies will not be formally acted on by the Board until the regular meeting following the presentation of such policy to allow time for review and possible exchange.

The Board will appraise its policies periodically in view of the changing needs of the community and schools.
