- Seasons
- F** Fall Start of Fall season is typically the first full week following the start of the school year.
End of Fall season is typically the day before Marathon Park opens first sheet of ice the first weekend in October.
 - W** Winter Start of winter season is typically the first weekend in October whenever Marathon Parks opens up first sheet of ice.
End of winter season is typically the third weekend of March upon conclusion of Timberlines ice show.
This changes based on Spring Break Schedule and Easter weekend.
Requests for ice time during the Fall and Winter time period need to be received by May 1st.
Changes will be negotiated through June 21st and final schedules will be distributed by June 30th.
 - S** Spring Start of Spring season is typically the first week following the completion of the Timberline ice show.
This changes based on Spring Break Schedule and Easter weekend.
End of Spring season is typically the first full week following the completion of the school year.
 - V** Summer Start of Summer season is typically the first week following the completion of the school year.
End of Summer season is typically the day before the start of the school year.
Requests for ice time during Spring and Summer time period need to be received by December 1st.
Changes will be negotiated through January 7th and final schedules will be distributed by January 15th.
