School Attendance Areas

Each student shall attend the elementary school located within his or her attendance area.

Exceptions may be made if extenuating circumstances arise. This decision will be made by the Superintendent of Schools or a designee.

The Superintendent may permit a student to complete the school year at the school attended at the beginning of the school year, even though the student is living in another attendance area of the district providing the district need not transport the child.

The district will attempt to accommodate parents requesting to have children of a family attend the same school when one child attends a special program in a school outside their attendance area. The determination will be made by the Superintendent or designee after considering class size, number of special needs students, benefits for the students, and other appropriate data. Transportation will be provided only if room on existing buses permit and route extension is not required. The Superintendent may rescind prior authorization to non-special program students after considering class size, number of special needs students, benefits for the students, and other appropriate data.

A parent may appeal to the School Board for an exception to this policy.

A map showing elementary attendance areas can be viewed on the school district website. Contact the bus contractor for specific determination if you live close to a boundary line and are unsure.
