Assignment of Transfer Students K-12

ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE - The schools in the D. C. Everest Area School District are organized on a K-5, 6-7 8-9, 10-12 plan. Elementary schools include students from kindergarten through grade five. The middle school includes students in grades six and seven. The junior high school includes students in grades eight and nine and the high school students in grades ten, eleven and twelve.

Students transferring to District schools from other schools or a Home-Based Private Educational program as defined in Sec. 115.001 (3g) and 118.15 (4) Wis. Stats. shall provide the District with transcripts and/or other records evidencing their level of academic achievement, subjects completed, credits earned, and results of standardized testing. Students shall be placed in the appropriate grade level and/or courses as indicated by records provided to the District.

For the purposes of this policy, placement refers to grade placement in grades K thru 12. All placement procedures are outlined in 5119R.

The terms of this policy are not to be confused with the statutes and other policies dealing with students with disabilities
