

INSTRUCTIONElementary and SecondaryTitle I Comparability

The D. C. Everest Area School District is dedicated and committed to the task of providing the best education possible for every child. The District ensures internal comparability so that an equal opportunity is available to each student regardless of the school they attend.

All programs and services provided for Title I students shall be at least comparable. The D. C. Everest Area School District has established and implemented a district-wide salary schedule and will use state and local funds to provide services in Title I project areas, which if taken as a whole, are at least comparable to services being provided in areas not receiving funds under this chapter.

The D. C. Everest Area School District will ensure equivalency among schools or grade levels within the District in the provision of:

- Teachers, administrators, and auxiliary personnel
- Curriculum materials and instructional supplies

Documentation verifying compliance with this policy will be maintained annually and records will be updated on a biennial basis documenting compliance. These records will be available for SEA or auditors review upon request.

It is understood that unpredictable changes in enrollment or personnel assignments which occur after the beginning of a school year need not be included as a factor in determining comparability of services.
