Choice of Studies

Alternative Programming

A student or a parent/guardian of a student may request a program or curriculum modification, including but not limited to:

1. Modification within the student's current academic program.
2. A work experience or work-study program.
3. Enrollment in an alternative public school or program located within the district.
4. Home-bound study including tutoring and nonsectarian correspondence courses.
5. Enrollment in any public education program outside of the district when there is a contractual agreement between the boards of the two schools.

At the beginning of each school year, students and their parents will be informed of their capability to ask for alternative programming.
