

STUDENTSElementary and SecondaryProgressYouth Options

This policy shall be administered in accordance with Wisconsin State Statute 118.55 relating to regulations for Youth Options Programs.

- A pupil is limited to enrollment in no more than 18 postsecondary credits, total, in his/her junior and senior years at D.C. Everest High School through the Youth Options program.
- If a pupil receives a failing grade in a course, fails to complete a course, or drops a course at an institution of higher learning or a technical college for which the School Board has made payment, the School Board will request reimbursement for all costs related to the course. Pupils will be ineligible for further participation in the Youth Options Program until payment is made.
