School Age Parents

School staff will cooperate with the parents and physicians in working with pregnant students. Any medical recommendations will be considered by the school's administration as they consider educational programming for the pregnant student.

When students have been medically unable to attend school, provisions for a homebound program may be appropriate. Regulations governing school age parents will be followed.

If the student requests information or assistance from the Student Services Department, guidance staff will make every effort to give assistance to the student through the offering of financial information and other assistance. Provisions for correspondence, night courses, and other educational offerings will also be considered.

Pregnant students continuing in the regular school program may be excused by the principal from participating in any classes or activities which would be inappropriate for medical or other reasons.

School counseling will be provided when requested for students returning to school after termination of their pregnancy.
