

INSTRUCTIONINSTRUCTION OF SPECIAL EDUCATION STUDENTS

In order to provide for children whose present and future educational needs are not being satisfactorily met in a regular classroom, special classes will be organized as these services are needed and to the extent it seems feasible to do so.

The instruction of children with disabilities (CWD) will be provided as defined through state and federal statutes and in line with action by the Individual Education Program (IEP) team. This includes students who have cognitive disabilities, hearing impairments, speech or language impairments, visual impairments, emotional disturbance, orthopedic impairments, autism, traumatic brain injury, other health impairments, learning disabilities as well as any combination of the above listed handicaps.
