

Bylaws of the BoardGeneral Statement

Bylaws are rules or procedures adopted by the D.C. Everest School Board to govern its internal operations. The use of such guide- lines or bylaws helps the board to carry out, efficiently and effectively, the responsibility and duties delegated to it by law and by the local electorate.

Organization

The corporate name of this school district is the D.C. Everest Area School District. The School Board has officially adopted the name as the D.C. Everest Area School District. The Board shall have the election of officers as required by law at its organizational meeting which shall be held at the first board meeting following the fourth Monday of April.

Number of Members and Terms of Office

Wisconsin Statute 120.01 provides that a common school district operating elementary and high school grades may have seven school board members.

The term of a member shall be three years.

Members elected at the spring election shall take office on the fourth Monday in April.

Filling Vacancies

A vacancy on the School Board is caused by the events in accordance with Wisconsin Statute 17.03.

The School Board shall decide by majority vote to fill an open position or to leave the position open until the following spring election.

The appointment shall not be for the unexpired term, but shall be until such successor is elected and qualifies [Wisconsin Statute 17.26(1).]
