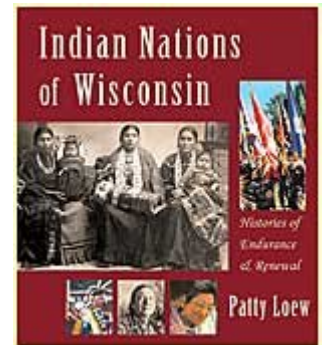


# Socratic Dialog # 1 Preface and Chapters 1 & 2
