

# Easton-Hatley Elementary School Supply List

Many times, materials and supplies that are brought to school are not useful. In general, students only need basic school supplies. Students in the upper grades will need additional items that are not required for a student in the primary grades. We hope the following will help you. Individual teachers may have a few additional items, which you will be informed of in the fall. Also, be prepared to replace any of these items when they become unusable or lost. **Back to School sales provide a great opportunity to stock-up on supplies!**

## Kindergarten

These items are for group use and do not need to be labeled with your child's name:

- 2 boxes of small Crayola crayons 1-8 Count and 1-24 Count
- 1 box thin Crayola washable markers
- 1-8 oz. bottle white Elmer's glue
- 6 sharpened pencils
- 2 packages of stickers
- 5 plain colored pocket folders (no designs/pictures)
- 1 box of Kleenex

These items are for personal use. Please label them with your child's name:

- Backpack
- Paint shirt
- Fun pad or coloring book
- Plastic rest mat
- A change of clean clothes in a plastic bag with the child's name (in case of spills, accidents etc...)

These items are optional:

- Small stuffed animal or doll to use at rest time
- Favorite book/books to read at rest time
- A daily healthy snack for morning milk time

## First Grade Supplies

- 12 pencils, sharpened if possible
- 2 erasers (large, basic pink or green)
- Crayons (16 or 24 count) limited space in school box and desk
- Washable markers (8 count)
- 4 regular pocket folders (1 blue, 1 yellow, 1 red, 1 green)
- 8-10 glue sticks
- 4 low odor expo brand dry erase markers
- Plastic school box with snap lid
- 1 composition book (9"x7 1/2")
- 1 large box of Kleenex
- 1 empty paper towel roll
- Backpack or school bag
- Painting smock or old shirt labeled with child's name
- \*\*Optional – a pack of stickers for classroom use
- \*\*Gym shoes worn on gym day.

## Second Grade Supplies

- 12 or more pencils
- 2 erasers (large, basic pink or green)
- 2 red pens
- Crayons 12 pack or larger
- 1 pack markers assorted colors
- 4 or more EXPO brand dry erase markers
- 2 glue sticks and 1 bottle glue
- 1 pencil box
- 4 plain pocket folders (no designs)
- 3 notebooks plain cover (no design)
- 2 composition notebooks
- 1 large box of Kleenex
- 1 box small zipper sandwich bags if last name begins with A-M
- 1 box large zipper sandwich bags if last name begins with N-Z
- Backpack or school bag
- Painting smock or old shirt
- Gym shoes worn on gym day.
- \*\*Optional – a pack of stickers for classroom use
- \*\*Optional-colored pencils
- \*\*Optional-pencil top eraser

### Third Grade Supply List-Hatley

- 4 dozen #2 pencils (no refillable lead pencils please.)
  - 2 or more erasers
  - 1 blue or black pen
  - 12 colored pencils
  - 1 pencil sharpener w/holder for shavings (NOT battery operated)
  - 1 -12 inch/30cm ruler
  - 3 glue sticks or 1 bottle glue
  - 1 pencil case (not a box)
  - 5 two pocket folders (1 red, 1 yellow and 3 others)
  - 1 package of wide lined paper
  - 1 large box of Kleenex
  - 4 book covers (can use paper bags or jumbo sized stretchy ones)
  - 1 old clean sock or small rag to use as an eraser on white boards
- \*\*\*Optional: one box of crayons\*\*\*
- Glue and pencils will be placed into “classroom community buckets.” Please do not label these items. All other item’s can be labeled with the student’s name.
  - Scissors, 5-subject notebooks, whiteboard markers, and calculators will be provided to the students.

### Fourth Grade Supply List-Hatley

- 2-3 large packages of pencils
- Pens in assorted colors (no light yellow, light green, etc.)
- 1 box of markers, crayons OR colored pencils
- 1 black Sharpie, fine point
- Glue
- 1 soft sided pencil case (no large plastic type) OR Ziploc bag for supplies
- 2 heavy duty folders 1 red, 1 green
- 1 regular folder for Music
- 3 spiral notebooks (3 different colors, labeled with child’s name only)
- 1 large box of Kleenex
- 1 old clean sock or small rag to use as an eraser on white boards

### Fifth Grade Supply List-Hatley

- 2-3 packages of 24 number two pencils
- Pens any color (gel pens are ok if they are not a light color)
- 1 box of markers, crayons OR colored pencils
- 1 or 2 black Sharpies (fine point)
- Glue stick or glue
- 1 soft sided pencil case (no large plastic type) OR Ziploc bag for supplies
- 2 heavy duty folders 1 red, 1 green
- 3 spiral notebooks (3 different colors, labeled with child’s name only)
- 1 large box of Kleenex
- 1 old clean sock or small rag to use as an eraser on white boards
- 1 white t-shirt to tie-dye in May for the Jay Seiler Track Meet (if new, wash it before sending it.) Write child’s name on the back tag or back, inside collar. Consider making it one size larger than they are now.
